

## Community Benefit Fund

### Projects to be offered funding through the first two years:

- A publicly accessible defibrillator for Lawhitton Parish
- Replacement of the flat roof for the Parish Hall, incorporating roof insulation
- A direct contribution to the insurance costs for St. Michael’s church, Lawhitton, enabling the listed church to stay open and offer a range of services to the community (funerals, weddings, weekly services, etc.)
- The provision of two sight screens for Launceston cricket club enabling youth and women’s teams to benefit from improved facilities.
- Provision for V learning net to provide a year’s programme to engage elderly and vulnerable residents of Lawhitton in improved computer/internet literacy and remote access to services such as banking and prescriptions.
- Painting and decorating of the main room in the Parish Hall.
